ONLINE TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

OVERVIEW

Master Builders Association of NSW Pty Ltd (Master Builders) is a Registered Training Organisation offering nationally recognised qualifications and courses across New South Wales which meet national industry standards.

The **BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management** course has been designed to reflect the role of individuals who apply project management skills and knowledge. They may manage projects in a variety of contexts, across a number of industry sectors. They have project leadership and management roles and are responsible for achieving project objectives. They possess a sound theoretical knowledge base and use a range of specialised, technical and managerial competencies to initiate, plan, execute and evaluate their own work and/or the work of others.

Participants will be assessed against skills and knowledge that meet current industry requirements for the building sector.

This course is suitable for anyone wanting to progress their career and working in all sectors of the building and construction industry.

ENROLMENT

You will be required to provide evidence of meeting entry requirements upon enrolment, including any transcripts you have achieved from any prior training.

On enrolment, you will be required to provide copies of:

- Drivers licence (photo ID with address)
- Green Medicare Card or Passport
- A valid White Card

Participants will require sufficient language, literacy and numeracy skills to be able to engage in the assessment and to perform workplace tasks such as reading different types of texts, completing written documentation and recording work outcomes. If you require assistance, please contact us to discuss options available to you.

It is anticipated that the course will take up to 12 months to complete.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Master Builders applies the following entry requirements:

- You have a valid White Card (General Construction Induction Card)
- You are currently working on active construction projects
- Must be more than 18 months into your building and construction apprenticeship, trade qualified or have a strong understanding of the building and construction industry
- Computer skills to undergo online training and assessment activities

SMART AND SKILLED

This training may be subsidised by the NSW Government under the Smart and Skilled initiative. If you are eligible for the government subsidy, your student fee will be determined by the NSW Government.

Smart and Skilled prices are subject to funding availability. Fees and funding will be confirmed once we have received your successful application.

To be eligible, you must also meet the following Smart and Skilled eligibility criteria:

- You are at least 15 years old
- You live or work in NSW
- You are an Australian citizen or permanent resident or a humanitarian visa holder, or a New Zealand citizen
- You are no longer attending school



COURSE STRUCTURE

The course is designed to be delivered online and comprises of 12 National units of competency.

It is designed to teach participants how to manage all aspects of construction projects including leading teams of people, managing changes and project risk, effective resource management, project planning, finance management, stakeholder management, scope, integration and manage construction project work.

There are online lessons which you can do to gain further understanding of the subject area. These can be undertaken at any stage of training and will assist in applying project management knowledge and skill.

Participants are expected to be able to complete the course and have completed all assessment requirements within a maximum of twelve (12) months. This course will require a study commitment of approx. 10-15 hours per week.

The course is described below, including the units of competency applicable to each subject. To achieve the BSB50820 Diploma of Project Management you will need to successfully complete all 12 units of competency.

You learn a variety of project management skills in different subjects, including;

- Project Initiation
- Project Planning
- Monitor and Control Projects
- Executing Projects
- Closing the Project

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RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS

The online pathway will require you to have access to at least the below items:

- Computer with internet to access:
 - o Online learning materials & courseware
 - Assessment materials
- Currently working in the building and construction industry and have access to company policies and procedures and any standard forms / contracts used in building and construction.

ASSESSMENT METHODS

You will be required to complete your assessment activities online, including sections for:

- Knowledge questions
- Practical projects

The knowledge questions are a series of questions designed to be answered comprehensively. These questions relate to different units within the qualification and assess understanding of tasks and project management processes within the construction industry.

The practical projects are based on application of project management in the construction industry. They draw upon your skills in the subject area and encourage you to apply these skills in your projects. These tasks include documentary evidence, whereby the completion of forms / contracts and other related documents are required to be uploaded into your online learning portal. Detailed instructions of evidence required and tasks to be undertaken are included in the online portal.

Assessments are to be submitted online (via the portal). Assessment activities may require you to have access to:

- National Construction Code
- Australian Standards
- Company safety documentation
- Project plans and specifications

Once your assessment has been submitted, your trainer / assessor will enter feedback and your results online. You will be notified by email accordingly.
