OVERVIEW

Master Builders Association of NSW Pty Ltd (Master Builders) is a Registered Training Organisation offering nationally recognised qualifications and courses across New South Wales which meet national industry standards.

The ***Kitchen, Bathroom and Laundry Renovation***, workshop offered by Master Builders is designed for tradespeople who want to expand their skills and progress their careers. The course covers elements of cabinet making to give you the skills and knowledge to undertake new builds and renovations.

This course provides an educational outcome in kitchen, bathroom and laundry renovations.

Upon successful completion you will achieve a Statement of Attainment in MSF30322 Certificate III in Cabinet Making and Timber Technology for the units successfully completed.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The program Kitchen, Bathroom and Laundry Renovation includes a collection of nationally recognised units of competency. This course meets part of the training requirement to gain a Kitchen, Bathroom, & Laundry Renovation licence from NSW Fair Trading. Upon successful completion of this course participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment (SOA).

By attaining a Kitchen, Bathroom and Laundry Renovation licence you can expand your business by contracting licensed tradespeople to undertake work involved in the installation, refurbishment, restoration and on-site repairs to a kitchen, bathroom, or laundry.

You will be provided with learning material and lessons online, where you will also undertake assessment activities. You will also be given the opportunity to attend a specialised practical workshop where your skills, knowledge and experience will be assessed by a Master Builders assessor. Assessment will be undertaken through knowledge questions, practical observations, and an online portfolio of evidence. Practical workshops will be conducted at Master Builders Education Centre in Baulkham Hills NSW.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Master Builders applies the following entry requirements:

- a minimum of one year's full-time (or equivalent) kitchen, bathroom, and laundry renovation related experience in the construction industry (experience must be within the last 10 years)
- a valid White Card (General Construction Induction card)
- currently working on active related projects
- able to provide details of two referees to confirm your work history/experience. Referees must be licenced builders or renovators qualified in KBLR / cabinet making and have worked with you for 12 months or more.
- able to answer at least 65% of the technical industry questions correctly during your application process.
- Ability to use technology / computers to undertake assessments and provide evidence.

This online and practical workshop pathway has been designed to meet part of the NSW Fair Trading criteria to apply for a Kitchen, Bathroom and Laundry Renovation Contractor Licence. NSW Fair Trading have specific criteria in addition to this course.

RESOURCE REQUIREMENTS

As a large component of this course is online, you must have a computer or digital device with internet access.

We will require you to have access to at least the below items when you attend the workshops:

- A valid White Card
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
- ID, including Driver's Licence and Medicare Card
- Computer or digital device with internet access

MBA will provide other resources, tools, and materials during the workshop.

ENROLMENT

You will be required to provide evidence of meeting entry requirements upon enrolment, including any transcripts you have achieved from any prior training.

On enrolment, you will be required to provide copies of:

- Driver licence (photo ID with address)
- Green Medicare Card or Passport
- A valid White Card

Participants will require sufficient language, literacy, and numeracy skills to be able to engage in the assessment and to perform workplace tasks such as calculating materials, interpreting building plans and specifications, and recording work outcomes. If you require assistance, please contact us to discuss options available to you.

It is a condition of enrolment that you have access to a computer to undertake online training and have resources / job sites where you can undertake practical projects.

This program is delivered over a six (6) month period, whereby you will be required to complete all online assessments and attend the workshops within this timeframe. We encourage you to undertake the workshop, however in cases where you have access to your own projects that meet the assessment requirements, you can submit photo / video evidence of this. You will have up to six (6) months to complete this program.

TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

There are pre-recorded online tutorials that are delivered by our trainers where you can watch content related to the units in this course. You will undertake various activities which demonstrate your skills and knowledge. Once the online content and assessments have been completed, you will have the option to either provide practical evidence of fabricating and installing furniture by either:

- Collecting workplace evidence by providing video or time-lapse photographic evidence of your practical projects, or
- Attending a two-day weekend workshop

You will be assessed through your performance of these activities to ensure that you meet the criteria and requirements for each unit of competency to a satisfactory level.

Master Builders provides structured knowledge questions, opportunities for practical observations, and guidance to create and submit a portfolio of evidence.

During the workshop days, your assessor will assess your knowledge and performance of practical tasks, and prescribe one of the following outcomes:

1. If you are assessed as 'competent' in all units of competency, you will progress to Master Builders certification stage for a Statement of Attainment in MSF30322 Certificate III in Cabinet Making and Timber Technology for units achieved.
2. If you are assessed as 'not yet competent' in any of the units of competency, you will be provided with an individual plan for gap training and / or further assessment. In this plan, you will be advised what further experience you require, or evidence of skills gained before you can proceed to the certification stage.

Knowledge questions consist of short answer questions designed to be answered with either dot points, short pieces of information or a couple of sentences. You will be required to complete the questions online and submit them to your assessor for review and assessment.

Your assessor will explain each task and require you to demonstrate your performance of each task whilst they observe. While you are performing the task, the assessor will make notes on your performance and will provide you with feedback and the result of their assessment.

ONLINE AND WORKSHOP STRUCTURE

In order to successfully complete the ***Kitchen, Bathroom and Laundry Renovation***, participants must be assessed as competent in the below six (6) units of competency. The units of competency offered by Master Builders are:
